The Library's research collections are open to the public Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:30 am-4:30 PM and Tuesday and Thursday, 12:00 PM- 8:00 PM. The Library also maintains a circulating collection for use by members of the fraternity. Books may be borrowed in person, through the mail, or in our digital library.

The Library currently offers 17 Reading Courses, which are described in more detail on the Library's website. Enrollment in a Reading Course is open to Masons who are in good standing of a Lodge under the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of the State of New York. Physical books are lent for a four (4) week period and may be renewed for an additional four (4) weeks through phone or e-mail. Ebooks are loaned for three (3) weeks
